Background

TYA-UK Centre of ASSITEJ is a registered charity and a company limited by guarantee which aims to represent the interests of those working in or committed to professional Theatre for Young Audiences in the UK. We are the UK Centre of the International Association of Theatre for Children and Young People (ASSITEJ).

Members of the International Association are mainly nation states as recognised by the UN. UK has an elected International Representative, who is currently a member of the international Executive Committee.

What is TYA-UK?

TYA-UK is the legal body representing the whole of the UK but we recognise the increasing divergence of the contexts within which our members in Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland and England now work. Accordingly the Board of TYA UK has TWO MEMBERS from each of the four parts of the UK.

Being a Board Member

If elected as a Board member for England, your duty will be to work with those representing the other parts of the UK to encourage international exchange and collaboration, develop mutually useful projects and ensure that TYA-UK's financial and legal obligations are met.

What You Do

You will be expected to attend up to six meetings a year of TYA England and a smaller number of TYA-UK meetings. TYA UK meetings are usually held at existing gatherings, like festivals, or may be conducted electronically. Your overriding responsibility is to represent faithfully the needs and aspirations of all UK members.
