



TYA REPORT on the 18th ASSITEJ World Congress

The <u>18th ASSITEJ World Congress</u> and Performing Arts Festival (Korczak Festival Special Edition) was held in Warsaw, Poland, May 23-31, 2014, presented by ASSITEJ Poland and the Zbigniew Raszewski Theatre Institute. The theme was 'Facing the Audience'.

Nearly 50 UK delegates attended the Congress,10 artists supported by TYA UK made possible through Arts Council England's, Grants for the Arts. The UK had the largest international delegation which included both veterans of ASSITEJ such as Paul Harman, Vicky Ireland and David Johnson, along with a larger number of UK artists who were visiting an ASSITEJ Festival for the first time including <u>Joseph Coelho</u>, <u>Charlotte Mountford</u> and <u>Beth Caudle</u> of <u>Lunabug Theatre</u>. At the ASSITEJ Congress

For the first time in it's 50 year history, ASSITEJ voted overwhelmingly (with 81% of the vote) to meet in the UK as Birmingham was selected as the host city for the 2016 ASSITEJ Artistic Gathering. The World Festival of theatre for young audiences will be co-presented by TYA UK and TYA Ireland, aiming to raise the profile and status of TYA within the UK and internationally. The Festival will be programmed by Purni Morell, AD of the Unicorn Theatre. An open meeting for all TYA UK members will take place in Birmingham on September 22nd to discuss the shape and content of the Festival.
